**Intermediate:** The above skills plus increase, decrease, and follow simple patterns.

**Advanced:** The above skills plus yarn-over patterns, cables, and ribbing; comfortable with pattern interpretation.

**All Levels:** Classes in this category are of interest to all knitters, regardless of skill level.
